> Television Packaging Guidelines

SAFETY NOTE: TVs can be very heavy. Use safe lifting practices when handling TVs to avoid injury.

SINGLE TELEVISION: If you have a TV to recycle, please bring it to our customer service area. We will help you unload your recyclable TV from your vehicle. No packaging is required.

MULTIPLE TELEVISIONS: If you have multiple televisions to recycle, please follow the following packaging guidelines to assist us in the safe handling of the TVs and to prevent injury to yourself and our employees.

- TVs must be stacked on a pallet wrapped in plastic “shrink wrap” to secure the load. (Pallets are commonly 42” x 48”. We can assist you obtaining pallets.)
- Place the heaviest TV(s) or wooden consoles on the bottom of the pallet for stability. **DO NOT STACK** wooden console TVs on **top of plastic-encased TVs.**
- Stack TVs with their glass screens facing inwards. **DO NOT STACK** with the glass screens face down on the pallets.
- The height limit for a stacked pallet of TVs is **4 feet** (no higher please!)
- Pallets of TVs must have a **minimum of 5 layers of plastic shrink wrap!** The plastic wrap must start from the bottom and **move up, tightly wrapped** to secure the load during shipping and handling.
- **DO NOT STACK** Projection Tube Televisions!
- **DO NOT STACK** TVs in GAYLORDS (4’ x 4’ x 4’ pallet cardboard boxes)!
- **DO NOT MIX MATERIAL TYPES** (i.e. **DO NOT** stack a pallet with computer monitors and TVs)

Off-specification fee(s) can result from improperly packaged televisions. The off-specification sort fee is \$50.00 per hour.
